- 1. ) After local anasthesia you will experience numbness in lips, teeth or tongue and you'll be unable to chew until anasthesia is worn off.
- 2. Temporary filling may wore off so avoid eating hard or sticky foods
- 3. Remember that proper oral hygiene must be continued. Flossing and brushing are must.
- 4. If the antibiotics are prescribed, you must complete the entire course.
- 5. If you're experiencing pain and discomfort after the procedure, you may use overthe-counter painkillers. Rinsing with warm salty water may be helpful, too.
